Undergraduate Notes

Data is current as of the date listed at the bottom right of each page.*
2. *The numbers on this report are a count of unduplicated degree records. Since some undergraduate students earn multiple bachelor's degrees (e.g., B.A. and B.S.) in the same academic year, and each degree has its own primary major, these students are counted twice on pages 1-2, with a separate "Unduplicated Headcount" row indicating how many unique students completed a degree in that year. Students completing a second or third major within a single bachelor's degree program are counted once on pages 1-2 and also counted on page 3.*
